His work emphasizes humanity's connection with the natural elements that surround us.

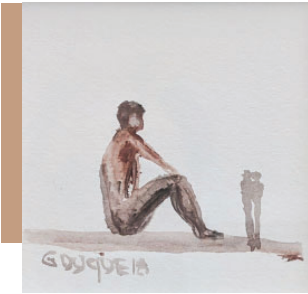
A visit to the gallery on Calle Hidalgo will often find David in the process of creating another work.

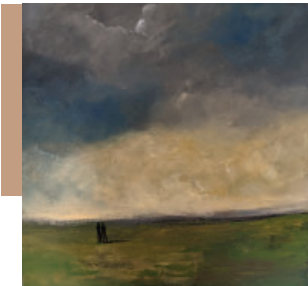

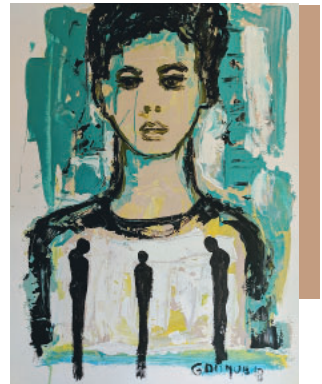

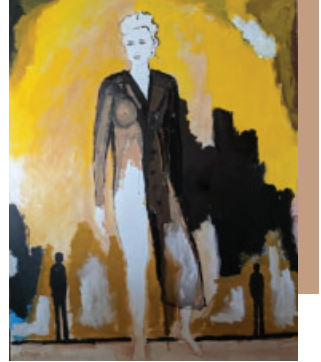

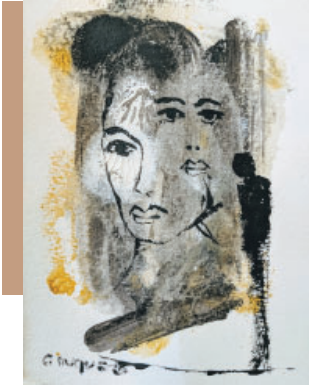

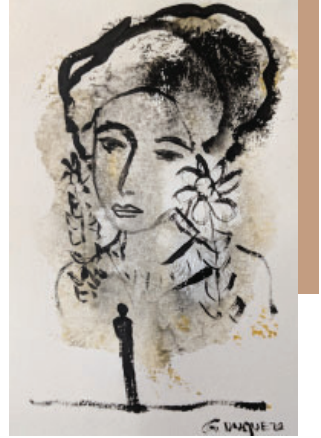

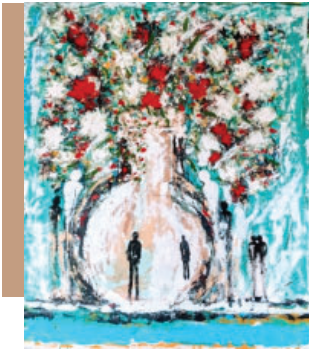


"Concubina"

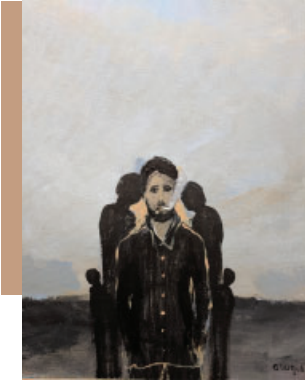
"White Flowers on Blue"

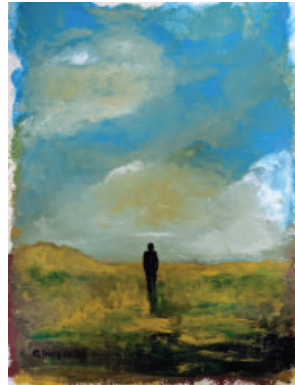

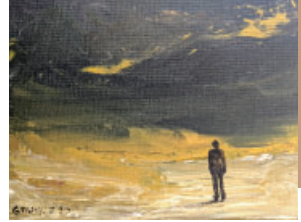

— San Miguel Photographs

The black and white photographs in the hotel are by Arturo Suárez García (1910–2001). He is known for visually chronicling the transformative period (1930 to 1970) of San Miguel's development into a UNESCO world heritage city.

The collection of over 1,200 plates is in the process of being digitized by the Fundación Arturo Suarez to preserve them and prevent their valuable historical information from being lost.

Mexican graphic prints are hung throughout the hotel. They provide key insight into understanding Mexico's rich history and cultures, such as the Olmec, Toltec, Teotihuacan, Mayan, and Aztec.

People in these cultures recorded important life events, including rituals, wars, human sacrifices, and legends about their rulers, by using pictures. After the Spanish conquest, indigenous artists fused Christian symbols and Native images in depictions of devils, skulls, and demons.
